HOUSEHOLD WASTE

CONTAINER PLACEMENT

- » Curbside by 6:30 a.m. on collection day
- » Wheels against curb or 2 ft. from the blacktop
- » Away from overhead obstacles such as trees
- » 4 feet apart from other containers and away from mailboxes, parked vehicles, and fences

HOLIDAY COLLECTION

» Containers are collected on all holidays except:

Independence Day Christmas

Thanksgiving New Year's Day

» Should a holiday fall on a scheduled collection day, all collections will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week, to include a Saturday collection. The normal collection schedule will resume the following week.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- » Flammable material, gas, paint, coal, or hot ashes

- » All materials should fall freely from the cart when dumped please do not overload.
- » Lid of the cart must close completely branches should not stick out of the container.
- » Place cart curbside by 6:30 a.m. on your scheduled collection day during seasonal periods April through November.
