RESOLUTION NO. 20-48

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACTION PLAN FOR THE CARES ACT FUNDS ADMINISTERED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE USE OF THOSE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has been tasked with distributing CARES Act funds to “entitlement” communities to help address the needs of low- and moderate-income residents affected by the COVID-19 Virus; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Jordan qualifies as an “entitlement” community under the CDBG Program and has received an allocation of CARES Act funding from HUD; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive the HUD-Administered CARES Act funds, the City of West Jordan must submit an action plan to HUD, and enter into associated agreements signed by the Chief Executive Officer of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH:

Section 1. The HUD-Administered CARES Act Action Plan (attached as Exhibit “A”) is hereby approved.

Section 2. The adopted annual budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 reconciles to the HUD-Administered CARES Act Action Plan.

Section 3. The Mayor, serving as the Chief Executive Officer of the City of West Jordan, or his designee is hereby authorized to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City of West Jordan’s HUD-Administered CARES Act Action Plan, and to sign associated agreements.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
