ORDINANCE NO. 21-12

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ACTION PLAN FOR THE ROUND 3 CARES ACT FUNDS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2019 AS ADMINISTERED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE USE OF THOSE FUNDS RESULTING IN AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has been tasked with distributing CARES Act funds to “entitlement” communities to help address the needs of low- and moderate-income residents affected by the COVID-19 Virus; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Jordan qualifies as an “entitlement” community under the CDBG Program and has received an allocation of CARES Act funding from HUD; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive the HUD-Administered CARES Act funds, the City of West Jordan must submit an action plan to HUD, and enter into associated agreements signed by the Chief Executive Officer of the City; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the City Council adopted the City’s Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has prepared an Amended Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and has submitted the same to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on March 10, 2021 concerning the Action Plan and amended budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH:

Section 1. The HUD-Administered Round 3 CARES Act Action Plan (attached as Exhibit “A”) is hereby approved.


Section 2. The adopted annual budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 reconciles to the HUD-Administered Round 3 CARES Act Action Plan.

Section 3. The Mayor, serving as the Chief Executive Officer of the City of West Jordan, or his designee is hereby authorized to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City of West Jordan’s HUD-Administered Round 3 CARES Act Action Plan, and to sign associated agreements.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
