Maximum Height: The A-frame sign shall not exceed 4-feet in height. Density: One sign per business is allowed. Spacing: 75-feet from any other sign. Front Setback: The A-frame sign must be within 20-feet of the primary entrance to the business. Limitation on Use: In those zoning districts where A-frame signs are permitted, their use is limited to areas of high volume pedestrian traffic. Display Period: Use of an A-frame sign shall be limited to normal business hours. Signs shall be stored indoors at all other times. Weather Restrictions: A-frame signs shall not be used outdoors when high wind or heavy snow conditions exist.
